HOW MANY STUDENTS FOR 2015?

To assist with 2015 planning, it is important that we know the approximate number of students who will be attending our school next year. If students will not be returning in the new year (other than our current Year 6 students of course), please advise the school office as soon as possible. If you know of any families who intend enrolling their children at our school from the beginning of next year, please advise them, also, to contact our school office (Ph: 6652 4488) so that contact details can be recorded, enrolment documentation organised and enrolment interviews booked. Your assistance with this would be greatly appreciated.

CLASS ALLOCATIONS FOR 2015

Processes for organising classes for 2015 have commenced and we are gathering additional information which will be of assistance with this. Therefore, I extend to parents/carers the opportunity to submit in writing any information about their child for consideration by administration and staff when organising 2015 class placements. Information should be provided in writing and labelled "In Confidence" and forwarded to the Principal by Friday, 7th November, 2014. This information might focus, for example, on medical conditions, specific learning needs and even friendship groupings. As initial staffing arrangements for the 2015 school year will not be finalised for a little while longer, it is inappropriate to suggest/request which teacher should or should not be allocated to your child. All available information will be considered to enable the best possible educational placements for all our students for the coming year.
