ORARA HIGH SCHOOL MATHS AND SCIENCE FAIR

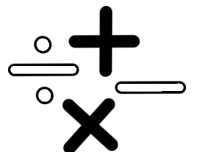
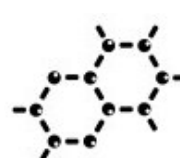
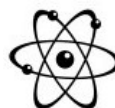

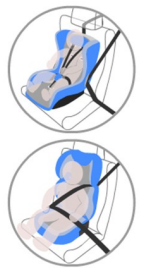
SEAT ME SAFELY

This term Tyalla is learning about keeping ourselves safe. This includes the Road and Bike safety programs, Pet Safety, Child Protection Anti-Bullying. We want our students to be safe and happy at school, at home and in the wider community. Please see your child's teacher if you would like more information about their classroom program.

Children between 4 years and 7 years

Forward Facing

Booster Seat



Children aged between 4 and 7 years must be restrained in either a forward facing restraint or a booster seat. This will depend on the size of your child. When your child has outgrown the inbuilt harness in the forward facing restraint they can move to a booster seat which uses the adult lap sash seatbelt.

Booster seats manufactured to the 2010 Standard have shoulder height markers which indicate when your child is too big for that booster. You may need to use a taller booster. Booster seats will have **red indicators** for the belt path.
