Tawny Frogmouths are not owls. Although they look similar, Frogmouths are more closely related to Nightjars, which are nocturnal birds known for having long wings and short beaks. Tawny Frogmouths emit a soft "oom-oom-oom" two to three times in a row. There are about 40-45 different species of Tawny Frogmouths.

- Our national emblems are wattle, kangaroo and emu.



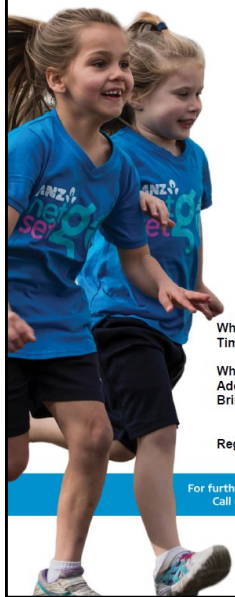
COFFS COAST COMMUNITY CIRCUS
