Our next P&C Meeting is on Monday, 28th November at 6.00pm. Everyone welcome.

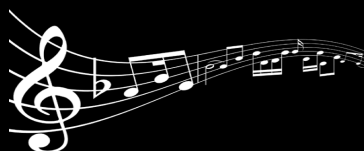

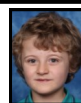

INTENSIVE SWIMMING

Our Intensive Swimming program will run from Monday, 28th November to Friday, 9th December and is offered to students in Year 2 and above. The program runs every day (Monday to Friday) for 2 weeks. Cost is \$40 per student which includes pool entry and bus. This has been heavily subsidised by the P&C from funds raised at this year's Show & Shine. Permission notes, together with payment must be returned to school no later than Friday, 21st November (weekly progress payments can be made but must be finalised by 21st November).
