DROP OFF ZONE

Did you know that we have a 'Drop Off Zone' at the front of Tyalla. This area is clearly signposted as an area in which parking is not allowable from 8.00am-9.30am and 2.30pm-4.00pm. Unfortunately, this area continues to be a source of frustration and complaints from parents as people do not use the zone correctly. Please be considerate when using this zone. **By law you cannot turn off or leave your car, just remain in the zone while children leave or enter your car.** The quicker you move in and out of the zone, the easier it is for others to use it. Moving to the front of the zone is a courtesy that ensures space for the next parent.

If you ask someone else to collect or drop off your children, please inform them about using the drop off zone. Please use these areas responsibly and safely.

The simplest way

...to keep lunch foods fresh.

Food packed at home in the lunch box needs to stay fresh and safe to eat at school.

Meat, fish, poultry, eggs, noodles, rice, pasta, custard, yoghurt, cheese and milk need to be kept very cold to prevent food poisoning.

Pack lunches in a cooler bag with a cold brick.

Freeze items such as sandwiches, milk poppers, yoghurt, custard tubs, muffins, or fruit segments to pack on hot days.
