**The next Election Day meeting is this Friday, 24th June at 2.00pm outside the canteen. Hope to see you there.**

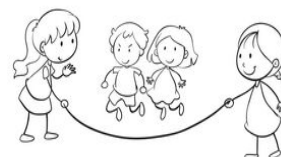
